BOD Meeting

June 13, 2020 10:00am

Meeting Place: Casa Grande, Invitees: Jay Alderman, Scott Pike, Dan Forbes, Jessy Zamora, Fred Frazier, Ken & Robert Mlynarz Meeting called to order by Mark Williams.

Roll Call: Mark Williams, Karen Bergman, Roger Combs, Steve Bell, John Bergman, Tiger Volz., Doug Sims, Richard Lane and Marty Benko. Steve Long was absent.

Treasure's Report: Steve passed out the latest bank statement. The report did not have many changes. Also, passed out was a report on the HOF, Western Zone and State Shoot costs. The State Shoot financial report will be adjusted due to being postponed to October. Motion by Roger, 2nd by Richard, was accepted.

Mark ask John if there was any news from ATA on the Grand. John said they will decide location on Monday or Tuesday. Possibly, it will be in Sparta or Missouri. Also, the Western Zone will be at Tucson. Marty ask about AZG&F rules and if they apply the same to Flagstaff. Marty stated shooters not happy about the way this happen. John spent much time contacting shooters and the executive board about moving the Western Zone Shoot to Tucson. John said there was several issues at Flag and the decision was his and ATA's decision not ASTA to make.

Mark ask Scott about the web site newsletter. He wants to keep up to date information. Scott said he will look into it to have it set up better. Scott ask to have the clubs send any information including scores from big fifties.

Old Business: Mark talk about the 2020 State Shoot in Tucson and ideas about shirts, hats and trophies. Roger ask if any work had been done on the traps at Ben Avery. Golden West did an inspection of their equipment. John said he did an inspection three years ago. John said he would do it again and Steve Bell will help him. Motion made by Marty to have a drop-dead date for the State Shoot. September 15 was seconded by Karen and motion passed. There were still questions about pre-squadding and dinner.

New Business: Roger made a motion to change the daily fee back to three dollars and seconded by Steve. The vote was three for and four against. Motion failed. All American points frozen until October 31. John will check them. Mark ask about targets requirements for the State Team. After discussion was held, we need to talk about it more in April. Roger made a motion to cut the requirements in half (50%), seconded by Tiger, and motion passed. Steve stated that National Trapshooting Day has been changed to Nation Trapshooting Month starting this October. Also, the 2019 taxes have been filed and paid. Ben Avery might start shooting Big 50's. Prescott GC might start shoot Big 50's next year. Steve has the 2021 stickers and has most of the green sheets for next year. After discussion to change the ASTA rule to ATA rules regarding birthday and classification adjustment, John Bergman will bring this up at the State Meeting for a vote to change the ASTA rules reference at the State Meeting motion ASTA rules. Doug passed out programs for the Western Zone Shoot to be held at Tucson. ASTA will give 4 boxes of shells for trophies. Karen and Tiger will look into range bags for the State Shoot Team.
