1. Classification/squadding and practice opens at 8:00 AM each day. Events start at 9:30 AM each day.
2. Entries for the first event each day must be cashiered no later than 30 minutes after the event starts.
3. Targets may be cross-registered with PITA. PITA Daily Fees \$4, AZ \$2
4. Juniors and Sub Juniors will be offered \$22/100 entry fees courtesy of 2 Lazy 2 and the ASTA.
5. HOF Attendance Pins for Participants
6. HOF 100/200 Straight Pins on Championship Events
7. Standard Orange Top White Flyer Targets will be thrown. If you wish to keep your empty hulls, please pocket them.

Tournament Rules

1. Arizona Residents must be current ASTA members at the time of classification/entry.
2. Daily Fees will be charged once per day per participant. ATA \$3 — ASTA \$2
3. ATA Rules govern all events. By entering an event, shooters agree to abide by all ATA Rules and Regulations and to accept all official decisions.
4. Classification will be in accordance with current ATA Rules and based on the shooter's official ATA registered averages and known ability. Please have your average card up to date to ensure proper classification. There will be five classes, five categories and four yardage groups. There will be no class or yardage penalties.
5. Trophies will be awarded in 5 categories Wednesday through Friday to Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior. Trophies will be awarded in 6 categories Saturday and Sunday to Lady, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior. A special category shooter whose event score qualifies for a *special category trophy is not eligible for class or yardage trophies*. A special category shooter whose event score *does not qualify for a special category trophy is eligible for class or yardage group trophies*. Please check your cashier's sheet to make sure your category as indicated is correct. Only classification errors will be corrected.
6. Ties will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap ties will be shot off if any of the involved shooters has a yardage change. There will be no class advancements for this shoot, however, any shooter's class/score is subject to review. Any remaining ties will be shot off Sunday following the handicap.
7. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap due to missed squads or gun repairs. Make-ups must be completed immediately following the event.
8. Any shooter who has not received monies won during this tournament, agrees that payment in the form of a check will be mailed to the address indicated by ATA records. When mailed, neither 2 Lazy 2, the BACTC or the ASTA will be liable for any checks lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered or otherwise not received by the shooter. Checks not cashed within 90 days will become void.
9. The consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to shooting in any event, including shoot-offs and practice, is not allowed and will result in disqualification of any scores shot. The BACTC does not allow alcohol on the premises.
10. Management reserves the right to change/modify the shoot program at their discretion if deemed necessary.

2022 HALL OF FAME

Karen's story...

I was born in Brooklyn, NY, grew up in Queens, moved to Manhattan and then Long Island. A New Yorker throughout my life.

From the time I was a child I was "identified" as an artist. If I got in trouble, it was because I was a "temperamental" artist, even before I knew what that meant. It was because I was always drawing, painting, doodling.

I graduated from NY Institute of Technology where I majored in art, painting and sculpting. I was able to build giant sculptures in collage because all of the equipment was provided. After school, I focused on painting as I couldn't afford to make giant sculptures. I got a job as an assistant/apprentice to a well known Photo Realist painter who trained me to a degree where she could leave me in the studio to produce paintings that would find ready acceptance in the marketplace. I had many gallery exhibitions and commissions. I still get the occasional commission and sale. Being involved in the art world in Manhattan, I did not come across any hunters or shooters (that I know of).

After my first marriage dissolved in a heap, I met John at a mutual friends gathering. We were friends first and then began dating. We married 5 years later in 2001. One day John suggested we go trap-shooting. Before going to the range we spent hours in the house, him teaching me about gun safety, how to load the gun (yes, I knew Nothing) and mostly how to hold the gun tightly into my cheek and shoulder. A lesson which has served me well and one I still need to practice.

The first trip to the range I broke 17 targets and was hooked. I loved blowing things up! Still do. Still get excited at beautiful breaks.

We belonged to the Peconic River Sportsman Club on Long Island for many years. We shot all over NY and up and down the east coast, including PA and Vandalia. We bought an RV, started getting smaller dogs (easier for traveling) and spending more time on the road. Between us we have 6 beautiful children, and now 6 beautiful son and daughter in laws. And especially, wonderful grandchildren. We are very blessed on the home front.

We moved to Prescott in 2010. John calls us Political Refugees. We are. We are more comfortable with the like minded people we found in Arizona. Besides, the climate, which for us is close to ideal, Prescott has a wonderful Wild West feel, the gun club is close by, and the people in our town are warm and welcoming. The shooting friends we've made, especially, Sherry and Kenny Shatz and Nancy and George Miller, and so many others are very special to us.

Through my involvement on the Board of Directors (an amazing group of generous and dedicated people) and John serving as delegate, we are finally able to give something back to the sport we love and to help newcomers get involved in Trapshooting.

Of all my experiences in my trapshooting adventure, being inducted into the AZ Hall of Fame is by far the most exciting! Thank you to the Hall of Fame committee and all the AZ shooters who didn't who didn't object.
