- I. Call to Order**
 - a. Meeting called to order at 4:00pm by Greg Holden, President.
- II. Roll Call**

- V. ATA News**
 - a. Don Williamson reported that Lynn Gipson had passed away and will be replaced by Randy Meullar.
 - b. Don will be writing a monthly article on AZ news for Trap and Field magazine, due every month on the 25th. The articles will be posted on the ASTA website on the ATA Delegate's Report page.
- VI. New Business**
 - a. Western Zone:**
 - i. Shoot will be managed by NASR and 2Lazy2 (Cherel) plus BOD directors that are attending the shoot.
 - ii. Walter to order the silver coins and holders for the trophies.
 - iii. Greg Spiczka is providing Sub-Junior and Junior trophies for the Thursday and Friday events.
 - iv. Mike Petrisko offered to create a detailed shoot checklist that can be used for planning and execution of the Western Zone (and any future ASTA sponsored shoots).
 - v. Phantom Sure Shots will have an open-air grille each day of the shoot for burgers, dogs, chips, and drinks.

b. Hall of Fame Shoot:

- i. HOF date is set for January 13-17, 2027.
- ii. The ASTA HOF Committee received written nominations for induction to the AZ HOF from Kenneth Mlynarz for Robert Mlynarz for Shooting Excellence and from Mike Petrisko for Steven Bell for Contributions to the Sport of Trap Shooting). Nomination for Robert Mlynarz was seconded by David Landwerlen and nomination for Steve Bell was seconded by Greg Holden. Walter provided ATA records for Robert and Mike Petrisko will put together the information on Steve Bell.
- iii. It was recommended that we put a committee together to plan and manage the shoot since we seem to always have issues with Ben Avery equipment. Committee members TBD.

c. State Shoot

- i. The 2027 AZ State Shoot will be held at Tucson Trap & Skeet Club March 16-21, 2027.
- ii. 2027 State Shoot discussions will be held over the next few months.

VII. Other Topics

- a. Due to the early resignation of Chris Cusumano, Mike Petrisko was nominated by Greg Holden to replace Chris as Northern Zone Director, effective immediately, for the remainder of Chris' term. Motion was second by Walter Allen and passed.
- b. The Board reviewed a request to waive the ASTA daily fee for the SCTP Commissioner's Cup trap shoot held at Tucson on April 18. Due to the explicit rules in the ASTA Bylaws pertaining to collecting daily fees, we are not allowed to waive the daily fee. A motion was made by Greg Holden to uphold the bylaws and not waive the daily fees. Motion was seconded by Walter Allen and passed. A notification was to be sent to the shoot organizers from the ASTA Secretary informing them of the decision.
- c. It was decided to hold a monthly remote BOD meeting on the second Wednesday of each month at 7pm, starting on Wednesday May 13.
- d. Walter to purchase Zoom subscription for ASTA use for all meetings going forward.

- e. It was also decided that the board will require the Treasurer to provide a monthly financial statement prior to the monthly call. The Finances will be reviewed at the monthly meetings.
