2. Entries for the first event each day must be cashiered no later than 30 minutes after the event starts.
3. Targets may be cross-registered with PITA. PITA Daily Fees \$4, AZ \$3
4. Juniors and Sub Juniors will be offered \$30/100 entry fees courtesy of 2 Lazy 2 and the ASTA.

We invite you to share this honor with Darvin during the HOF festivities on Saturday following the Singles Championship. A complimentary dinner will be served.



Darvin Thomas

The ASTA Board of Directors are pleased to announce the 2026 inductee into the Arizona State Trapshooting Hall of Fame is Darwin Thomas. Darwin has an impressive record in trapshooting dating way back to 1976 when he first made the PITA All Star Team. His overall ATA average from 1984 – 1990 was an enviable 94.95 and at the 1986 Grand American, Darwin was the Doubles Champion, RU in the HAA, and 4th in the HOA. That takes some pretty good shooting to beat that crowd!

Darvin had many other trapshooting awards during that period including 1987 Spring Grand Singles Champion, CA State Shoot Singles and Doubles Champion, and Alaska State Shoot HOA and HAA Champion. He also made the All-American Open Team in 1986-87.

Darvin was the CA State ATA delegate in 1987 and in 1988, Darwin got his Grand Slam (#66).

After a pretty long break from ATA trapshooting (Darvin will have to tell us why), he got back into shooting in 2015 after moving to Lake Havasu, AZ.

Darvin racked up several more prestigious awards over the next 10 years winning the 2017 Autumn Grand Singles and Doubles Championships as well as several AZ State Titles including Sub-Vet and Vet Doubles Champion, AZ State Singles Vet Champion, and HOA Vet Champion. At this year's 2025 Grand American, Darwin shot a 198 in the Singles Championship event!

Darvin will be introduced by Tom Strunk at the ceremony where Darwin has promised to tell us a little more about himself and his trapshooting career!

Darvin becomes the 61st Inductee into the AZ Trapshooting Hall of Fame.

Tournament Rules

1. Arizona Residents must be current ASTA members at the time of classification/ entry.
2. Daily Fees will be charged once per day per participant. ATA \$4.00 - ASTA \$3.00
3. ATA Rules govern all events. By entering an event, shooters agree to abide by all ATA Rules and Regulations and to accept all official decisions.
4. Classification will be in accordance with current ATA Rules and based on the shooter's official ATA registered averages and known ability. Please have your average card up to date to ensure proper classification. There will be five classes, five categories and four yardage groups. There will be no class or yardage penalties.
5. Trophies will be awarded in 5 categories Wednesday through Friday to Lady, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior. Trophies will be awarded in 6 categories Saturday and Sunday to Lady, Sub-Veteran, Veteran, Senior Veteran, Junior and Sub Junior. *A special category shooter whose event score qualifies for a special category trophy is not eligible for class or yardage trophies. A special category shooter whose event score does not qualify for a special category trophy is eligible for class or yardage group trophies.* Please check your cashier's sheet to make sure your category as indicated is correct. Only classification errors will be corrected.
6. Ties will be carried over to the next like event. Handicap ties will be shot off if any of the involved shooters has a yardage change. There will be no class advancements for this shoot, however, any shooter's class/score is subject to review. Any remaining ties will be shot off Sunday following the handicap.
7. No shooter will be allowed to make up more than 50 targets on the practice trap due to missed squads or gun repairs. Make-ups must be completed immediately following the event.
8. Any shooter who has not received monies won during this tournament agrees that payment in the form of a check will be mailed to the address indicated by ATA records. When mailed, neither 2 Lazy 2, the BACTC or the ASTA will be liable for any checks lost, stolen, unclaimed, undelivered, or otherwise not received by the shooter. Checks not cashed within 90 days will become void.
9. The consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs prior to shooting in any event, including shoot-offs and practice, is not allowed and will result in disqualification of any scores shot. **The BACTC does not allow alcohol on the premises.**
10. Management reserves the right to change/modify the shoot program at their discretion if deemed necessary
